



BOZZO FAMILY 'SEI WHAT?' RED 2019

Bozzo Family Vineyards is a family-owned estate in Loudoun County, farming eight acres of grapes with a commitment to land stewardship and minimalist winemaking. With Stephen Bozzo Sr. as winemaker and Stephen Jr. managing the vineyard, the winery produces expressive, estate-grown wines that reflect sustainability, and a genuine sense of place.

VINTAGE NOTES

The growing season unfolded with steady warmth and balanced conditions from bud break through harvest. The vineyard's well-drained, stony loam soils supported even ripening across Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, and Cabernet Franc, producing clean, concentrated fruit ideal for blending into a smooth, expressive estate-grown red.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Each varietal fermented separately in small fermentation bins before completing malolactic fermentation in French oak. The final Cabernet Franc dominant blend with supporting Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot aged about 12 months in French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

This Bordeaux blend offers dark red and black fruits layered with cocoa and subtle toasted oak. Smooth, balanced tannins and lively acidity shape a lingering finish. This approachable, food-friendly blend showcases the estate's style and craftsmanship - recognized with a **Gold Medal at the 2022 Virginia Governor's Cup**.
